



the location - Scarborough







a **friendly** town

Anglolang is located in the traditional seaside resort of Scarborough on the beautiful North Yorkshire coast.


Scarborough has been the destination of choice for tourists since the 17th Century. It is the largest holiday resort on the Yorkshire coast, where a warm welcome meets every visitor. It has everything that is expected of an established seaside town which is rich in history, culture and charm, plus breathtaking countryside, offering peace and relaxation.

Local annual festivals provide excellent opportunities for international visitors to make English friends easily. These include Seafest, International Jazz, Scarborough Fayre, Scarborough Surf Festival and the Cricket festival.

convenient location

Anglolang is a ten minute walk from the beach and the town centre.

Scarborough is centrally located between London and Edinburgh, providing a good base for UK travel.











great choice

Scarborough provides a wide range of entertainment for people of all ages, such as the Sea Life Centre, Scarborough Art Gallery, the Open Air Theatre and the unique Spa Complex. The two main beaches provide a great source of enjoyment - the South Bay, with its fishing harbour, marina, cafes, and amusement arcades; the North Bay with its watersports and scenic parks. Both bays are separated by the magnificent medieval Scarborough Castle.

The resort also provides a great choice of high street shops and boutiques, as well as an indoor shopping centre. The pedestrianised town centre also boasts inviting cafes and bars.



lively nightlife

With many traditional Yorkshire pubs offering live music, two cinemas, several theatres staging concerts, ballets and summer shows, a casino and a wide range of restaurants and bars, it is easy to find something to do during the evenings. Scarborough is also home to the famous Stephen Joseph Theatre which hosts original plays by resident playwright Sir Alan Ayckbourn, before reaching London's West End.







motivating methodology

Anglolang has a modern, communicative approach to teaching. All classrooms are well-equipped, with interactive whiteboards. Teachers are able to use up-to-date, authentic resources from the Internet as well as digital English language course books.

flexible course structure

Anglolang's teachers consult their students and tailor lessons to meet their interests and needs. This is known as the 'negotiated syllabus' giving students flexibility and choice.

topic-based lessons

Lessons are based around topics, such as work, travel or current affairs.

skills

Teachers also focus on developing speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. Speaking, for example, is improved through discussion, role-play, mini-presentations and pronunciation activities.

grammar

Grammatical structures are introduced and reviewed according to the needs of students when negotiating the syllabus.

vocabulary development

Vocabulary is a very important part of all lessons at Anglolang. Teachers give advice on how to effectively record, learn and activate vocabulary.

class sizes

Although the maximum class size is 15 students for most courses, during the non-Summer months (from September to mid-June), the average class size is 8 students.









communicate with confidence

Communicative teaching methods are used to develop the skills needed to communicate in English with confidence. As well as increasing confidence when using English, teachers also focus on increasing fluency and accuracy.

short term courses

There are two short term Intensive English course options:

- 20 hours' tuition per week
 09.00 13.00, Monday Friday (incl. breaks)
- 35 hours' tuition per week 09.00 - 17.00, Monday - Friday (incl. breaks)

long term courses

There are two long term Intensive English course options:

- 20 hours' tuition per week
 09.00 13.00, Monday Friday (incl. breaks)
- 25 hours' tuition per week*
 09.00 15.00, Monday Friday (incl. breaks)
- * this course includes 5 hours per week examination classes

level

There are usually 5 group levels. These are

- Elementary
- · Lower Intermediate
- Intermediate
- · Higher Intermediate
- Advanced

It is recommended that complete beginners have one-to-one tuition before joining a group. All students complete a placement test before arriving at the school. Pre-testing allows students to begin lessons at 09.00 on the first day of arrival, to maximise learning time.

specialist courses

Professional English private tuition

There are four choices of Professional English private courses:

- 20 hours' private Professional English tuition per week
 09.00 - 13.00, Monday - Friday (incl. breaks)
- 25 hours' private Professional English tuition per week
 09.00 - 15.00, Monday - Friday (incl. breaks)
- 30 hours' private Professional English tuition per week
 09.00 - 16.00, Monday - Friday (incl. breaks)
- 35 hours' private Professional English tuition per week
 09.00 - 17.00, Monday - Friday (incl. breaks)

Effective Communication for Professionals

This is a specialist language and professional skills course which improves English and further develops the skills of:

- Presenting in English
- · Participating in English meetings
- · Negotiating in English
- Telephoning in English
- Writing e-mails, reports & letters in English
- Socialising & networking in English

With fixed start dates throughout the year, this course combines I week of training at Anglolang and 4 weeks of online learning.





Developing Intercultural Competence for Professionals

This is a specialist language and intercultural training course which improves English and increases awareness of cultural diversity. It develops skills for communicating and working successfully with people from a range of cultural backgrounds. This course also has fixed start dates throughout the year, and combines I week of training at Anglolang and 4 weeks of online learning.

maximum flexibility

One-to-one courses are perfect for people who want to achieve maximum progress in a short time, especially complete beginners or professionals.

individual needs

One-to-one tuition allows people to focus on their specific needs. Before arriving at Anglolang, a needs analysis questionnaire is completed, as well as the Anglolang placement test.

During the first lesson, a more detailed needs analysis takes place and consultation continues throughout the course. This allows the teacher to plan an individualised learning programme.



course options

Anglolang offers the following examination courses:

- Cambridge
- IELTS
- GMAT / TOEFL
- Trinity GESE

CAMBRIDGE courses

Anglolang's Cambridge English First (FCE) and Cambridge English Advanced (CAE) courses can be joined in January, March or September. Cambridge examination courses at Anglolang are pure Cambridge courses and students are not mixed with general English students. Cambridge students receive 25 hours of Cambridge examination classes per week (incl. breaks) in a group with a maximum of 8 examination students.

Anglolang can also provide combination courses of Intensive English + private tuition to prepare for Cambridge English Key (KET), Cambridge English Preliminary (PET) and Cambridge English Proficiency (CPE).

IELTS

The IELTS course can be joined on any Monday for any duration, offering maximum flexibility. Lessons are a combination of Intensive English and examination classes. The morning Intensive English classes are topic-based lessons, focusing on the four skills as well as grammar and vocabulary development. Afternoon examination classes focus on examination strategy and test papers. This course offers 25 hours' tuition per week (incl. breaks), of which 5 hours are examination classes.

GMAT / TOEFL

Anglolang's private tuition or combination courses allow students to prepare for GMAT and/or TOEFL. GMAT/TOEFL students are able to choose from 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30 or 35 hours' private tuition per week (incl. breaks).

TRINITY GESE

Anglolang provides Trinity GESE for groups upon request.





teacher training



practical classroom ideas

Anglolang offers stimulating teachers' courses for teachers who work in primary, secondary, vocational and adult education. These courses focus on language development and practical classroom methodology.

- English Language Training for Vocational Teachers
- English Language Training for Teachers in Adult Education
- Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)
- Effective Use of Technology in Teaching

pre-course e-learning

There is an optional pre-course e-learning phase for each teacher training course (additional cost). The 4-week pre-course e-learning allows participants to increase their confidence when using English and to network with other participants before the face-to-face course at Anglolang.

language development

All courses include English language development classes aimed at improving oral fluency, listening skills and vocabulary range.

classroom methodology

The methodology training in the afternoons focuses on interactive, communicative classroom activities. Depending on the chosen course, training sessions can include:

- Vocabulary learning
- Using social media and m-learning
- Using interactive whiteboards
- Motivating learners to speak
- Literature in the classroom
- Exploiting authentic materials

study visits

Teachers' courses also include a visit to a local school or college during term time. During the summer programme (mid-June to the end of August), all teachers' courses include one full day Wednesday excursion to a place of cultural interest.







championship golf course

Scarborough has two first-class golf courses, and there are several others close to Scarborough, including the famous Ganton championship golf course. North Cliff Golf Course has a cliff top start and finish, with stunning views of both the North Bay and Scarborough Castle. Similarly South Cliff Golf Course has coastal views. With little rough and few trees, the greens are well shaped to provide a challenge.

In co-operation with Scarborough's golf clubs, Anglolang offers the opportunity to improve English and play golf. English is practised in the morning and then golf can be played in the afternoon. Professional golf coaching can also be organised.

experienced golfer

For golfers with an official handicap, the course includes:

- 5 green fees (which can be exchanged for private coaching sessions)
- unlimited playing time on the course
- transport to the golf course

the beginner

For inexperienced golfers, without an official handicap, we can offer 3 hours of professional golf coaching and practice each afternoon.







learn English and have fun

Anglolang's Summer Vacation Course combines motivating English classes with fun cultural and sporting activities. Each week includes:

- 16 hours' group tuition per week (incl. breaks)
- organised afternoon activities
- · one full day study visit
- optional evening activities

Families are very welcome at Anglolang and lessons can be provided for all family members during the summer. Classes are formed according to age and English level.







welcoming homes

Homestay, guest house, hotel or self-catering accommodation can be arranged, within walking distance of the school. All accommodation is selected and inspected by an experienced Accommodation and Welfare Officer to make sure a high standard is maintained.

home stay

Staying in an English home is the best way to practise English and experience the British way of life, sharing the family mealtimes, conversations, walks and outings.

guest house (B&B)

A guest house is a small hotel with a homely atmosphere. The emphasis is personal and with individual service for guests. Depending on budget, a room with or without bathroom can be chosen. Breakfast is included and dinner is optional at some guest houses. Rooms usually have WiFi.

hotel

Scarborough has a range of hotels in terms of type, size, location and price. A hotel provides additional services to a guest house. These usually include bar and restaurant service, room service, and leisure facilities. All rooms are comfortably furnished and have a private bathroom, WiFi and tea/coffee making facilities.

private apartment

A self-catering apartment offers complete flexibility and total independence. All apartments are fully-furnished and have private bathroom and cooking facilities.
