These courses are designed for individual students who wish to make rapid progress over a period of one week or more.

Each course is specifically designed for the student, based on an in-depth needs analysis, placement test and phone interview before arrival in the UK. All course materials are included in the fees.

Our fees include extensive pre-course preparation:

- You or your company contact us for private, individual English tuition.
- We telephone you or your company directly and carry out an in-depth needs analysis.
- We send you an entrance test to complete before you begin your course.
- We then send you or your company a

proposed course syllabus including results of error analysis from the test.

Work experience administration procedures include:

- Finding a suitable company for your work placement experience.

- A telephone interview and needs analysis to find out what type of work experience you are looking for.
- Making sure that the company meets with the UK health and safety regulations.
- Contacting you at the end of the first week to make sure your work placement is satisfactory.
- Organising and administering a full report at the end of the work placement.

Junior courses

Course information

During the morning sessions between 9.00am and 12.30pm the students will study a standard General English programme and will focus on grammar, vocabulary and speaking practice.

Later in the morning the student will then focus on social and speaking skills each day throughout their stay. All lessons will focus on communication, allowing students to improve their fluency, grammar and listening, reading and writing.

The afternoon classes will allow students to study elements of British culture through class workshops and project work relating to some of the activities and events outside class time.

Abbey School

LanguageUK Juniors takes place at the Abbey School in Faversham.

The Abbey School (www.abbeyschoolfaversham.co.uk) is a British state school for 12- to 18-year-old pupils.

The school describes itself as a vibrant school offering exciting opportunities to their students whatever their ability. The Abbey School has welcomed LanguageUK and see this partnership

as an opportunity and experience for both the native and foreign students.

Wherever possible, both LanguageUK and the Abbey School will try to work alongside each other and try to encourage the students to meet.

Every day, the LanguageUK students will eat in the school canteen alongside the British school pupils.

Where can I stay when I study English at LanguageUK?

You can choose from a wide range of places to stay while you are at LanguageUK.

The following options are available to you and can be arranged on application:

Standard Homestay in Broadstairs

Students have the opportunity to stay with local, friendly English people in Broadstairs.

As we are a small school we can afford to be very selective with our homestay accommodation, ensuring our students feel very comfortable and welcome.

We believe this really helps you to study English here in England and allows you to practise your English after school and learn more about English life. A private room and half-board lodging is provided throughout the week.

All our homestay options have been specially chosen by LanguageUK and are regularly visited to ensure standards remain high.

They are situated as close to LanguageUK as possible and are either within walking distance from the school or on a direct bus route.

All Homestays provide the following facilities:

- A clean and comfortable private bedroom.
- A place to study either in the bedroom or in a quiet place in the house.
- Weekly laundry facilities at no extra cost.
- Breakfast and dinner every day.
- WiFi internet.

Executive Homestay

This accommodation is highly recommended for students who are looking for superior rooms.

All host families are carefully chosen for the Executive Homestay programme. These are a select group of host families that are experienced and offer superior accommodation and meals.

As in the Standard Homestay program, a host family can be a couple or a single adult with or without children. Our executive host families live in larger homes of a high standard.

Each student has a private room with ensuite, TV and WiFi internet with breakfast and dinner every day.

If you would like a family with certain qualities – for example, children, pets, private bathroom, vegetarian – let us know and we will find the right family for you.

Guesthouses and hotels

We work with a small range of bed and breakfast and hotel accommodation situated just a few minutes' walk from the seafront. The bedrooms are tastefully decorated and furnished to a good standard of comfort.

All rooms are fully en-suite with tea- and coffee-making facilities, colour TV and central heating.

The Albion Hotel offers stunning views of Viking Bay and all within a short walk of excellent bars and traditional pubs and a local cinema.

Self-catering

- Some students choose to rent a flat during their stay.
- We have a variety of self-catering options available upon request.
- Our accommodation officer will ensure that you are happy throughout your stay here with us and is always available throughout the day for any questions.
